For more than 25 years the Center for Sign Language and Gesture - SignGes (formerly known as DESIRE) has carried out research in the field of sign language. In 2014 the team joined forces with the RWTH Aachen University gesture research group which is specialized in recording and analysing gestures and other types of communicative behaviour using Motion-Capture Technology.

SignGes consists of hearing-impaired, deaf and non-deaf colleagues. Its successful work is rooted in a mix of applied and fundamental research in the fields of sign language, gesture, and general aspects of diversity.



