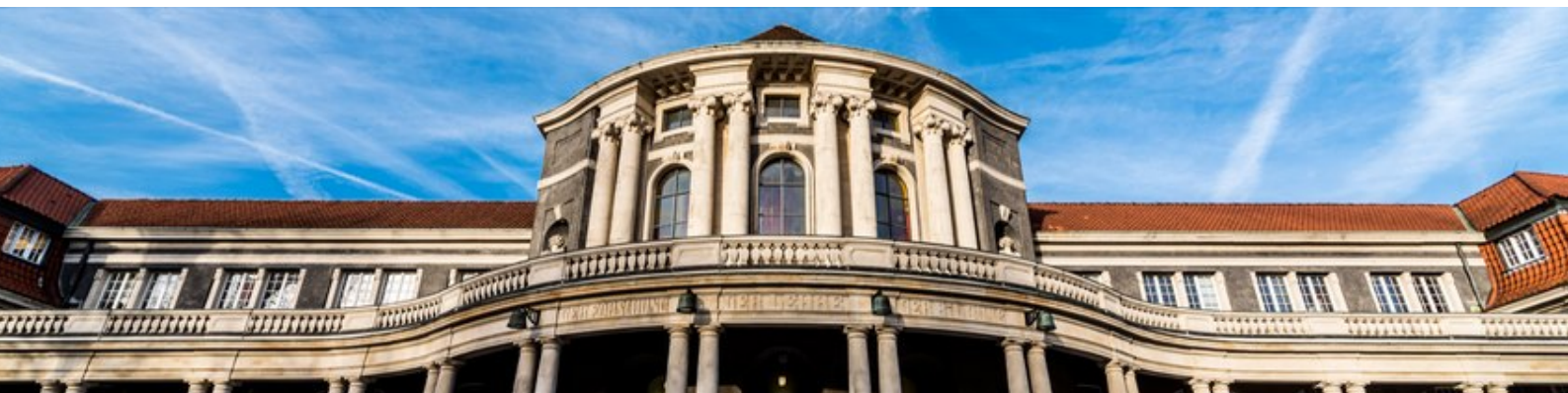

# Acting Professorship (W2) for Sign Language Linguistics

**Institution:** Faculty of Humanities, Institute of German Sign Language and Communication of the Deaf (IDGS)

**Salary level:** W2

**Start date:** 01.10.2021, fixed to 31.03.2022. This is a fixed-term contract in accordance with the German part-time and fixed-term contract act (Gesetz über Teilzeitarbeit und befristete Arbeitsverträge, TzBfG).

**Scope of work:** full-time position suitable for part-time

## Responsibilities:

The successful candidate is expected to teach and conduct research in the field named above. The teaching hours correspond to those required of the professorship to be temporarily filled, which is 9 teaching hours (LVS). Helpful are very good scientific skills and international competences, as well as excellent teaching experience. The acting professor will have access to staff and an existing material budget as well as resources for tutorials after consultation.

## Requirements:

Academic qualifications and additional requirements as specified in Section 15 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) apply.

## Additional Criteria:

The successful applicant is expected to have international research experience. The University places particular emphasis on the quality of teaching and therefore requests applicants to provide details of their teaching experience and objectives.
